I strive to support teenagers and their families to seek answers, navigate challenges, and ultimately thrive through compassionate, nonjudgmental, and culturally sensitive care for adolescents and their families.

#### *Accepting referrals for the following concerns:*

- Menstrual concerns, including heavy, painful, or irregular periods
- Birth control, including IUD and Nexplanon placements
- PrEP (Pre-exposure prophylaxis for HIV)
- Sexual health testing and treatment

*The above services can be provided through enrollment in the Family Planning/Title X Program to ensure patient confidentiality and service affordability.*

- Anxiety, depression, and ADHD evaluation and medication management
- Acne management
- Eating disorders, including bulimia and anorexia
- Hormone therapy for transgender and gender non-conforming youth
